

THE SPIRIT THAT RAISED CHRIST FROM THE DEAD

Romans 8:10-11

I. THE HOLY SPIRIT GAVE LIFE TO CHRIST (Rom 8:11).

- A. *God, the Father, raised Christ from the dead* (Ac 2:22-24, Rom 10:9, 1 Cor 6:14, 15:15, Eph 1:20, Col 2:12, Heb 13:20, 1 Pet 1:21).
- B. *Jesus also participated in His own resurrection* (Jn 10:17-18, 11:25-26, Heb 7:15-16).

II. THE HOLY SPIRIT WILL GIVE LIFE TO US ALSO (Rom 8:10-11, Jn 6:63).

- A. *That life is eternal life with God in heaven after we die* (Jn 3:16, 1 Cor 15:9).
- B. *It is resurrection life available and accessible to us right now* (Rom 8:11, Gal 2:20).
- C. *That life comes from the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus* (Rom 8:1- 2).
 - 1. The Spirit of Life precedes power (Rom 5:9-10).
 - 2. The Spirit of Life produces power (Rom 8:5-6, Jn 20:21-22).
 - 3. The Spirit of life produces power, which produces life, which produces power which . . . (2 Pet 1:3-4).
- D. *We can access this life through the Spirit of sonship* (Rom 8:14-16).
 - 1. The Spirit of sonship establishes relationship and intimacy with the Father.
 - 2. The Spirit of sonship confirms our identity and destiny.
